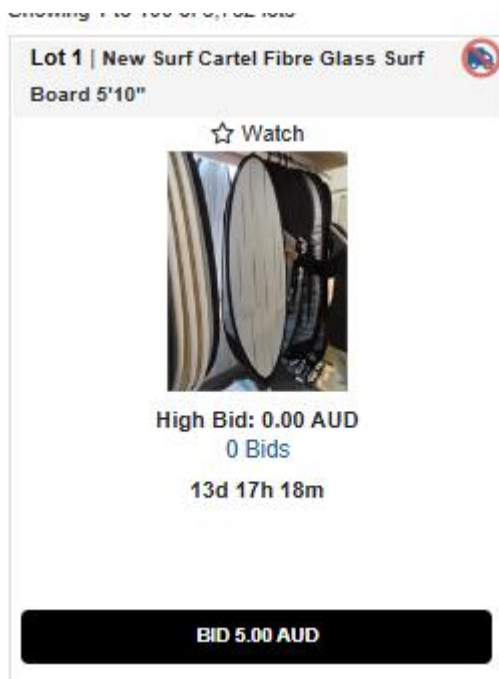
### **INSTRUCTIONS TO PLACE A "HIBID" ON AUCTION ITEMS**

When bidding in the auction, you are able to place what is called a "hibid". As the name suggests this is your maximum bid or "hibid" on any item. The system will then bid on your behalf up to this amount. It will only go to this amount if it needs to and will never go over it.

To place your Hibids follow the instructions below. You will need to register to bid in the auction first. If you haven't already done so, it is a simple process, these instructions can also be found at the top of our website.

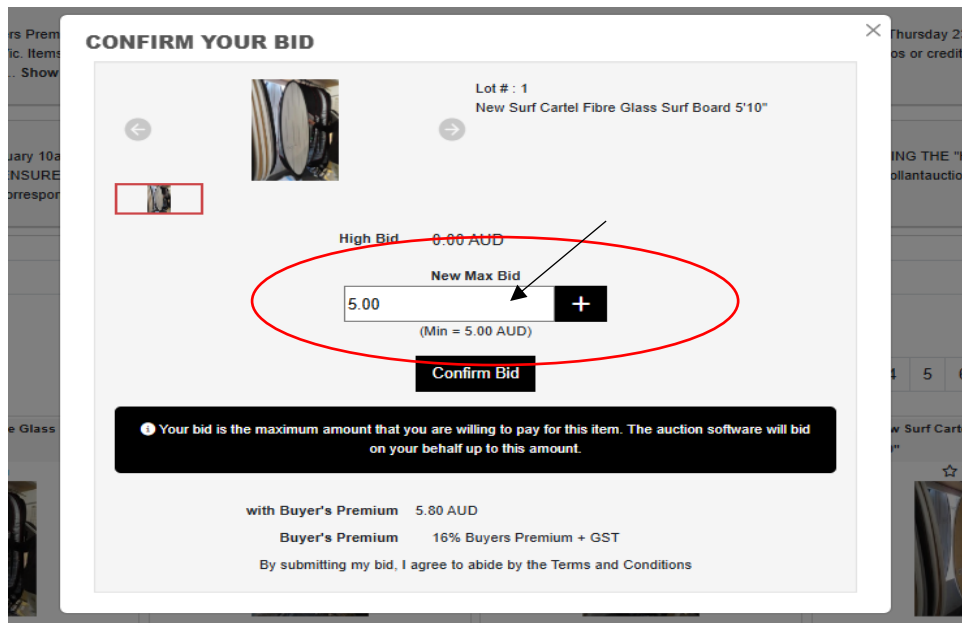
### **INSTRUCTIONS**

1. Find the lot you want to bid on in the catalogue and click on the black "bid 5.00 AUD" (this amount will vary depending on what bidding has been done on the item)

2. Replace the amount that is displayed in the "New Max Bid" window (see picture below) with the amount that you would like to bid up to by deleting the dollar amount and replacing it with your bid. Keeping in mind that there is 16% Buyers Premium and GST added to this price.



3. Once your amount is in click

**Confirm Bid**

and your bid will be placed.

You will receive an email notification if you are outbid. If you are the winning bidder, you will receive a notification saying “May have won” when your item closes on the day of the sale. This means you have won the item and will receive a paid invoice at the conclusion of the sale.
